‘Good for Human Rights, Good for Business’ - Stakeholder Dialogue in 4 countries

Thailand, Malaysia, Myanmar and Japan

Based on the human rights due diligence process outlined in the UN Guiding Principle on Business and Human Rights, CRT Japan has conducted the Stakeholder Engagement Programme (SHE) in Japan every year since 2012, offering an opportunity for constructive dialogue between companies and stakeholders. CRT Japan’s 2017 SHE will start in Thailand, Malaysia, and Myanmar, providing non-confrontational fora for face to face dialogue between businesses and stakeholders a core component of ensuring a ‘Responsible Supply Chain’, and of e.g. the UK’s Modern Slavery Act. In Japan, we will incorporate the issues and solutions identified in these three countries into our dialogue.



The SHE participation fee for Japanese companies is JPY 300,000 yen (ex. tax) for each component. There is no fee for stakeholders or local companies. The participation fee for dialogue with small scale palm oil farmers for Japanese companies is JPY 500,000 yen (ex.tax). Registration URLs are as followed.
